As we approach the final months of 2024, I reflect on our achievements with great appreciation for the collaborations we have had with like-minded individuals and organizations to ensure that rights are being realized in accordance with the law.

Over the past few months, #TeamKELIN has been buzzing with meaningful change in mind and has taken action to ensure it's not just events and activities as usual.

My key highlight is from our recent court victory, halting the prosecution of P.K.K., a domestic worker living with HIV who faced unfounded charges of HIV transmission. The court's decision to dismiss this case was a powerful reminder of the critical role KELIN plays in challenging outdated, discriminatory laws and fighting stigma. This success affirms our commitment to advocating for policies grounded in accurate science and justice for people living with HIV.

From our initiatives in HIV, TB, and Key Populations to our focus on sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR), as well as health governance, women's land and property rights (WLPR), and strategic litigation, I am pleased to share with you some highlights from our active pursuits.


